

2005 Pacific Rim International Print Exhibition

The 2005 Pacific Rim International Print Exhibition is presented by the Art Department of the University of Hawaii at Hilo with support from the Hawaii State Foundation on Culture and the Arts. The exhibition is presented in the Campus Center Gallery at the University of Hawaii at Hilo.

Eligibility: The exhibition is open to artists 18 years of age or older from the U.S. and its territories and the from countries and cultures of the Rim and the Basin of the Pacific Ocean. Eligible printmaking media are intaglio, lithography, relief, serigraphy, digital computer prints, and monoprints. The work must not be more than three years since completion.

Calendar: Entries are due: November 15th, 2004
Slide Jury: November 20th, 2004
Notification of results: December 5th, 2004
Work due in Hilo: January 15th, 2005
Exhibition opens February 15th, 2005
Exhibition closes April 15th, 2005

Fees: \$25.00/US. Entry fee payments from outside the United States should be in international postal money order. Entry fees should be made payable to **UHH Pacific States**.

Size: Work may not exceed 30 x 40" (76.2 x 101.6 cm) in overall paper dimensions. All work in the exhibit will be matted and framed under plexiglass for presentation.

Procedure: Artists should send no more than two (2) slides of work for preliminary jurying to the address below. Slides (positive transparencies) must be standard 2x2" (5x5cm.) mounts and should be labeled in the following manner:

1. Last name, first name, and address a larger of the top or right-hand border of the slide.
2. Title, date of work, medium, dimensions (inches) of the image on the opposite large border of slide (HXW).
3. Indicate the **lower left-hand corner** of the slide with a black dot.
4. Indicate the number "1" or "2" on the slide to conform to the entry form.

5. U.S. entries should include stamped, self-addressed envelope for slide return.

Dates: Send slides, entry form, and fee by **November 15th, 2004**. Invited artists will be notified in early December. Registration forms for the exhibition will be mailed at the same time. Work should be clearly labeled with the artist's name, address, email address, title, medium, and date of execution of the work. **All work should arrive in Hilo by January 15, 2005.**

The exhibition opens in October, 2005 in the Campus Center Gallery of the University of Hawaii at Hilo.

Jury: Preliminary jurying through review of slides. Final jurying of actual work will occur in Hilo.

Catalogue: For the exhibition catalogue, invited artists are asked to send one black & white photograph of the print, and a brief biographical resume or career summary. Catalogues will be sent to all participating artists and institutions throughout the Pacific Rim.

Shipping: Work should be sent **without mats or frames** in a reusable mailing tube. International shipping should be sent via air mail. Domestic shipping should be sent via priority mail. Work may be sent via UPS or Fedex, however return shipping from Hilo will be through U.S. Postal Service.
